Dear Parents,

Assalamualaikum Wr Wb,

It is with great regret that we have to write to parents regarding parking on the double yellow lines outside the Madrasah.

We have a patrol rota in place, with members of staff patrolling three times during the day: 4.45pm, 6.00pm and 7.15pm. Those on patrol stand outside in all weather conditions, whether dry, wet or windy, to ensure the safety and welfare of our pupils. We are asking parents NOT TO park on the double yellow lines on Grafton St and the exit of Lauderdale St (no entry sign), and to instead park their cars in a safe place, for example, on West Cliff or on Hartington Road, and then walk the extremely short distance to the Madrasah to drop off or pick up children.

Furthermore, there could be potential development plans via the land purchased on Grafton St. Therefore we do not want to upset the local residents and jeopardise any planning permission that may happen in the future. It is a very reasonable request and parents do have to bear in mind the consequences of illegal parking which causes obstruction to others.

A reminder of the parking guidelines as follows:

- Parents/guardians must not park on double yellow lines on Grafton St and the exit of Lauderdale St (no entry sign) - any vehicle parked will be asked to move according to the following:
 - **First time:** a verbal warning will be given.
 - **Second time:** a written warning will be given.
 - **Third time:** child suspension (if after a child had been suspended and the parking problem persists, then the child's position in Madrasah could be in jeopardy.)

This policy comes into effect immediately

We hope there will be no need for even a verbal warning once parents have read this letter and realise how important an issue this is, but rest assured that the Madrasah will carry out all the actions above if necessary. Collective cooperation is what we need to progress.
